

My Corona Antigen Test is positive – what must I keep in mind? (Status Mar. 14, 2022)

Why should I protect myself against Corona?

- People become ill.
- People infect each other.
- Some people become seriously ill or even die.



What are Corona symptoms?

For example you have a cough, a fever, a cold, you have no strength, you taste nothing, you smell nothing... some people have no symptoms at all.

Make an antigen test and a PCR-Test at a Corona test center

1. If your antigen test at home is positive → avoid to get in contact with other people → immediately make an antigen test or if possible a PCR test at a test center or go to a doctor → if the test is positive, stay in quarantine!
2. If your antigen test at school / in the day care center is positive → immediate quarantine → you have to make a PCR test at a testing center. An antigen test is NOT sufficient! → If the test is positive, stay in quarantine.

The Ludwigsburg District Office will send you a quarantine certificate by mail.

Quarantine

Stay at home! No visitors! At home: wear a mask, open the windows frequently, keep a distance from other people at home. The best is to stay in a separate room, disinfect well (especially the bathroom, toilette and kitchen.)




Maybe you have infected other persons (your close contacts)?

Inform your close contacts of the last few days. They should make an antigen test.

Your close contacts are:

- They live together with you in an apartment/a house.
- They were together with you more than 10 minutes without distance and without a mask.
- They talked to you without distance and without mask or they greeted you with kisses and hugs.
- They wore a mask in a badly ventilated room and were together with you for more than 10 minutes.

Note: Special rules apply at school!

*... when you have been free from symptoms for at least 48 hours at the time of the test.

Please note: After the end of the quarantine, carry the test certificate with you for at least 5 days.
